1. **Call to Order:** Due to lack of a quorum, there was no call to order. 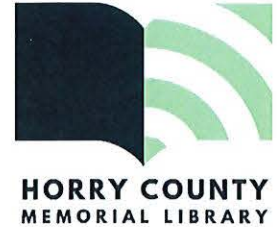

- *District 11 Board Representative:*
Mr. Hughes, District 11, has resigned his position with HCML Board of Trustees. Welcome, Lisa Ricketts as his replacement until June 30, 2023 and for a four-year term following.
- *Lyngsoe LibCabinet Opening to Public:*
The Grand Opening will be Monday, March, 13, 2023. Conway Library staff will set up an information and library card station. News media outlets have been contacted.



- *Socastee Library Playground:*
Horry County Parks and Recreation met with Library Administration and a representative from Little Tykes Commercial. An estimate for repairs has been prepared. Horry County Maintenance will work to secure an updated quote from them as a contracted vendor.

VI. Library Updates:

Aynor Library

January

- The library manager contacted a local artist to lead a painting program quarterly. The artist will lead a painting program for adults in March and then during Summer Reading for children.
- Staff contacted the local dentist's office for a technician to visit the library for Dental Health Month in February. They will attend storytime and teach the importance of good dental hygiene.
- January is National Puzzle month. A community puzzle was set up for patrons to collectively complete. This was a popular passive program, with the puzzle being completed long before the end of the month.
- Passive programs, such as chair yoga and family movie day, are consistently popular. Approximately 25 patrons participated in the events during January.
- On January 17th, storytime was held for 21 participants. The children made penguin poppers. The large group can be attributed to the fact that school was not in session this day.

February

- A Dr. Seuss book display was created in the children's room. Many of the books checked out the same day.
- The local League of Women's Voters chapter was on hand to ensure patrons had an opportunity to register to vote. The team spoke with twelve patrons over a two-hour period in the library.
- Staff have noticed an increase in attendance at storytime. There are now two homeschool families participating on a consistent basis. There is an average of ten children each week. It is a fun filled morning in the library.
- DVD circulation is down by approximately 50% from last month and last year. Most households have streaming services now making the collection less used.

Bookmobile

January

- The bookmobile has a new schedule and it is working well, with only a few adjustments.
- Outreach has begun at various retirement centers and apartment complexes.
- Storytime and material checkout have been implemented at many childcare centers, with a focus on the centers that have the First Steps 4K program in place.
- All circulation statistics have increased since being out in the community on a consistent basis.
- 779 people visited the bookmobile during January.

February

- Foot traffic, circulation and program statistics have all increased due to the new schedule, more retirement centers and more passive stops this month.
- The bookmobile visited Carolina Forest Elementary school for Multilingual Literary night on February 23. Approximately 75 people visited the bookmobile.
- Passive stops have been added between scheduled stops at centers. People definitely take notice during these times.
- Circulation statistics continue to increase as the bookmobile continues to follow a consistent schedule.
- 965 people visited the bookmobile during February.

Bucksport Library

January

- United Way continues to visit the library each 1st and 3rd Thursday, 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. With the amount of people benefiting from these services, the coordinator has expressed the possible need to come every week. They have helped many people in the community with rent, provided free cell phones, and a few veterans have gotten help with VA benefits.
- The basic computer class is being regularly attended with four to five people coming to each class. One student is an eighty-year old lady who really enjoys coming, and is upset if she is unable to attend.
- Staff placed a box of free books at the Community Center for everyone to take at any time. The staff at the center were happy to have the books. They anticipate the books being a big help for afterschool children. Library staff will replenish the books as needed.

February

- The staff at the Bucksport library have started asking local businesses and churches if they would place the events and programs flyers in the windows, or bulletin boards at their establishments. They have also asked the churches to put them in their announcements on Sunday mornings.
- The basic computer classes, being taught by Horry County Adult Education, have been a success. The classes will end on March 3. There has been such an amazing response that staff has asked if they would be willing to do another session. Staff have also decided to add other services they offer, such as a free GED test preparation and adult literacy classes.
- The Homeschool Book Club is a huge success. The children are excited that they get to interact with students they do not know. The theme for the month was read a book with a red cover.
- A community member donated \$100.00 to the Friends of the Library. He informed them that he will be donating \$800.00 more at a later date. Friends of the Bucksport Library were delighted along with the staff.

Carolina Forest Library

January

- Carolina Forest launched a new, year-long library program, The Year of Dewey. The branch has an unofficial mascot, a raccoon stuffed animal that children named Dewey Readmore in a naming competition years ago. This year, each month the library will have a different Bingo card with library and reading related activities. If customers complete the card, they can get a library-made pin featuring Dewey. If they collect all twelve pins throughout the year, they are eligible to win a prize. The Bingo card promotes many of our programs and library materials and is for all ages.
- As Carolina Forest continues to grow in population, there is a greater demand for more and varied programs. In response to this, staff were busy in January planning new programs for the upcoming months. They have set up a Pine Needle Basking Weaving class and a Calligraphy class for February, as well as other new programs such as a Birding walk, new book clubs, and a class on internet research skills for children. Staff have also developed a good relationship with Coastal Carolina University and are partnering with the University for a series of history lectures and other programs.
- The puzzle library continues to grow. It now takes up two entire bookcases. There is a dedicated puzzle community including patrons who come in several times a week to take a puzzle and drop one off. Patrons have even set up puzzle stations around the library, including a group of college students who do a puzzle every week in the YA

room. It has become a service that customers truly appreciate, especially those who use puzzles to help with memory and concentration.

February

- To better promote programs, staff undertook two promotional projects this month. The Branch Librarian redesigned the monthly calendar, changing the calendar format to an informational brochure. The brochure is broken into categories such as "For Creative People," "For Book Lovers," "For History Buffs," etc. and programs and events are listed under each category. This will make it easier for patrons to find programs based on their interests. So far, patrons have commented they like the new format. Staff also created a new information board on an easel by the front doors which lists events for the month. Patrons have already started to ask about programs they have seen on the board.
- The library began hosting tax preparation services through AARP beginning February 2nd. Patrons can get their taxes done for free every Thursday until April 13th.
- In February, several parents and caregivers reached out to request storytimes at hours other than the usual 11:00 am sessions. The youth services team decided to add a Family Storytime in the afternoon and possibly a noon Storytime to better accommodate families. Families have also asked for additional events for homeschool children at later times. Staff are working to accommodate these requests.
- The new Carolina Forest Library Youth Services Librarian position was posted. The new position is a much-needed role as the area continues to grow, and two new schools have been proposed nearby.

Conway Library

January

- Tax time is here! AARP used the meeting room for volunteer training and VITA began tax preparation in January.
- The Community Outreach Navigator from Careteam Plus in Conway set up an information table in the lobby on January 10th. She spoke with a lot of patrons coming in and out of the library about the health care related services and help provided by their organization.
- Conway staff is consistently working to clear clutter within the library. Procurement came to pick up a dozen large items which freed up enough space in the back room upstairs that it is able to be utilized by staff again. Keeping work spaces clean and sanitized has also been a priority with so many people in the community getting sick.
- Conway Christian High School teachers reached out a few months ago about teaching students how to conduct proper research as well as show them resources available through HCML. Each group started with a presentation in the meeting room of our catalog, digital resources, how to cite articles, etc. Then, the students practiced finding items relating to their research project physically in the library with help from librarians if needed.

February

- Youth Services staff shifted collections to better highlight the new Juvenile books. They now have a section, like the adult collections, for new books and the kids love it.
- Conway Library Staff started a multi-month shelf-reading project in February. One collection is worked on at a time, split up among the staff. If all goes according to plan, all collections will be in order before Summer Reading begins.
- A new Conway staff member created a resource binder for patrons looking for employment. It encompasses everything from resume writing to step-by-step instructions on how to apply to various large corporations and government entities in Horry County.

Along with this, the same staff member created a series of classes that will start later this spring to help with job searching, resume writing and interviewing.

- AARP and VITA have both reported to staff that their appointments are filling up fast this tax season. Neither organizations have any appointments open in March. The first two weeks of April seem to be filling fast as well.
- Even though coordinators from Coastal Carolina University were worried the weather would keep people at home, Gullah Geechee Community Day 2023 was a success. Two sessions were held in the Conway Library South Carolina Room with over 50 people in attendance.
- Quilts of Valor set up a sewing station in the children's room on March 4th, so anyone that wanted to see how the quilts were made could.

Green Sea/Floyds Library

January

- On January 5th, Shannon P. began working as a Youth Services Library Assistant. She has already been welcomed by the community, and she is eager to learn. She attended a Youth Services meeting at the Conway Library during her first full week.
- The Little River Medical Bus has remained a valuable resource for the community. A lot of folks are scheduling yearly appointments. The staff sees individuals of various ages. A growing number of parents are beginning to take their kids to well-child visits.
- Staff are having fun putting together programs. In January, themes were the Lunar New Year, Dr. Martin Luther King, and winter weather. Students had the opportunity to learn about and take part in a STEM activity every week. A highlight was making snow. The library and Horry County Parks & Recreation remain partners. On Mondays, programs are also provided to the Home School Meet Up Group. This group is still growing and going strong.
- The Horry County Adults with Disabilities took part in STEM-related activities. Their favorite activity involved the Playdough Discovery Kit. In addition, they like a good dance-off and bingo.
- Staff collaborated to deliver a class on macramé to teenagers. Some of the teens are eager for the next opportunity to pick up fresh knot-making skills.
- For the Adult Paint and Design Class, patrons were taught how to paint wintery mountains. It was the perfect painting for cold days.
- The Green Sea-Floyds Clovers 4-H club had a great time learning about healthy bodies and minds for the New Year. They learned about the history of yoga as well as some of the different poses. The day with a healthy snack and apple juice.

February

- Staff are collaborating to develop fantastic activities for the Green Sea-Floyds community.
- The Horry County Parks and Recreation partnership and the Home School Meet Up group are going strong. Students learned about Catherine Johnson's significant role at NASA in February. They created their own universes using paint and they 'went to the planetarium' using the Space Programming Kit. We also had a small Valentine's Day party, enjoyed Skill Toys, and played Valentine's Day Bingo. Students celebrated everything Dr. Seuss. They painted green eggs with a challenging twist. Students could not use green, blue or yellow paint.
- The Little River Medical Bus brought their tiny mobile clinic on several Mondays in February because their one exam room mobile clinic was out of commission. However, when they came back, they came back strong and in force. The new 40-foot-long mobile bus includes two exam rooms. Little River is having a custom mobile medical bus made and look forward to showing it off in the Green Sea-Floyds community.
- The Valentine's Day Drop-In was marvelous. Staff interacted with 77 patrons and handed out updated Friends of the Library pamphlets. Patrons created conversation hearts to share why they love the library.

- Staff screened a Bill Nye the Science Guy episode for Healthy Heart Week using the new projector and enormous screen. Students went outside to get in a good cardio workout with hula hoops and they played freeze tag.
- In February, the Adult Paint and Design class was well-attended. They painted bikes. Patrons could choose between a hint of spring and a little love. Most participants chose the spring bikes with baskets.
- The Friday library visits by the Horry County Adults with Disabilities continue to be a fantastic program. The group either obtained a new library card in February or renewed their existing one. The Adult Services Coordinator and Library staff collaborated to bring Rapid Reads to the library. Many adults like reading, but not all of them are prepared for long novels.
- Staff had a chance to host Family Feud with the seniors at the Horry County Council on Aging. It was fun for everyone and they look forward to the Steve Harvey impression again in the future.

Little River Library

January

- The "Ask the Doctors" series workshop, Weight Loss Solutions, was well attended.
- One-on-One Tech help increased with four new participants.
- AARP conducted a Driver's Safety course with students earning Safe Driver certifications.
- The Friends of Little River Library held the first book sale of 2023 on 1/20/23. The book sale was successful.

February

- Horry County Museum presented a Gullah Rag Quilting program.
- The adult craft class designed sweetheart pillows. The class was conducted by Sandy Lynch.
- Dr. Jamie Grainger presented a Healthy Hearts workshop.
- Black History Month was recognized with notable African American author book displays.

Loris Library

January

- Staff felt that door traffic had increased; A mid-month check 1/18 showed a total monthly count of 606.
- Loris Book Club met on 1/26. There were 9 in attendance and the selection for February was voted upon (*The Best is Yet to Come*, by Debbie Macomber). The book club welcomed one new member, while two other patrons have since expressed an interest in joining.
- A STEAM activity was held 1/26. Staff adapted the lesson on chemistry and the periodic table of elements by mentioning only the states of matter, and focused instead on the construction of a lithium atom using fruit flavored colored marshmallows and toothpicks.
- A box to collect adult diapers, wipes, and other adult-care products was brought in by the Diaper Dan non-profit on 1/31.

February

- On the day of the Hungry for History Chicken Bog marker unveiling, there were 57 people in attendance and the door count for the day was 206. Chicken bog was provided by Ritchie's, and desserts were provided by Mattie Jane's Bakery, both of Loris.
- Loris will be hosting a representative from United Way on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month
- The Loris Garden Club has resumed bringing beautiful arrangements to the library. The Garden Club is also working with the county to beautify the area around the new Hungry for History marker.

North Myrtle Beach Library

January

- The new Youth Services Library Assistant is picking up training quickly and has already stepped into her role in planning and implementing programming.
- All staff positions are filled. Staff have fully transitioned, re-trained on side tasks and safety, and informed of normalized expectations moving forward. The Branch Librarian updated training materials and met with each staff member individually for quarterly performance feedback.
- The Reference Librarian and Tech Services department continue to troubleshoot account issues with Facebook access. The Reference Librarian was able to resolve ongoing issues with the Loris Branch Canva account as well.
- Staff have finalized and clarified internal procedures and responsibilities for weeding/discarding in adult and youth collections.
- A patron returned the *Retro Games Discovery Kit* that she had checked out for her father, who has dementia. She said he absolutely love it, and he remembered playing with those toys and games when he was young. She said that as he opened the bag she could see an immediate change in his face, and that for a moment he seemed like himself again. The collection overall continues to receive a lot of positive feedback from patrons.
- The monthly Art Afternoon program is now presented as a mini-art lesson for kids. Staff created a lesson plan to introduce Eric Carle as an artist, showed a video of him creating art, demonstrating a technique with textured rub-on plates, and participants practiced the technique on their own. Parents engaged with the content, talking about the technique with their children as they worked on their project.
- A mom of three small children commented on the sensory playtime after Baby/Toddler Story Time: "We love story time and the play opportunities afterward. We especially love the messy play days because the kids get those experiences without us having to make a mess at home!"

February

- First-Aid training was shared with staff. The First Aid Kit was updated and restocked according to ANSI Class A kit standards. The Safe Place Training video was also reviewed with staff.
- The North Myrtle Beach program schedule was mapped out for the meeting room and new classroom space through the spring season of 2024. Availability of the rooms was provided to CCU OLLI through the Spring 2024 semester for planning purposes. With the addition of a new classroom space, North Myrtle Beach plans to increase options for library programs and community use, particularly during the busy tax/visitor season. Staff will begin shifting materials out of the room in March.
- Staff has expressed interest in training for library outreach and promotion events. The Branch Librarian will initially help staff prepare for and attend events to ensure effective promotion. It may also be a helpful topic for system-wide professional development.
- Responsibilities for Volunteer Coordinator were streamlined, files organized, and duties assigned to a designated staff member as a monthly side task.
- Patron comment: "Your children's room is so cute and has so much to do. We're on vacation and I feel like we need to go back to our library and give them ideas." Visitors may not be county residents, but they indicate that the library is one of their favorite spots when they vacation in our area. The library represents the county well, and we have a big positive impact on the vacationer's experience.
- One little boy was so excited to check out Peppa the Pig adventure pack he was squealing with delight 🐷 😊

Socastee Library

January

- The playground at Socastee Library is temporarily closed due to several safety issues.
- Additional mulch was added to the playground in January. The Maintenance Department did a fantastic job straightening out the outline of the playground.
- Socastee Library hosted its first "Local Author Talk." Eight local authors set up in the meeting room and discussed their writing with patrons.
- Socastee Library reached out to J. Rueben Long Detention Center to reestablish the book donation program that ceased due to COVID. A staff member is once again collecting books for inmates.
- Socastee Library had 3 pictures, painted by a local artist, hung in the library. They are a great addition to Socastee Library and have received many compliments.
- A large Ferris wheel was completed in January (made from the Engino Discovery STEM kit) by the YS Librarian.
- Friends of Socastee Library met on January 5th with six attendees. Discussions included updating the By-Laws and preparing for the Annual Meeting to be held March 9, 2023 @ 6pm. The 20th anniversary of Socastee Library's current location was discussed. The suggestion was made to place a plaque outside in the playground area as a rededication of the playground's memorial to Kyrie Katlinich.

February

- The basket weaving class was a success with nine people attending.
- Love-on-a-Leash a Reading to the Dogs program started at Socastee on February 6, with three dogs, Zoey, Gracie, and Scarlett, with 19 children reading to them. This event was held in the Community Center, which allowed more visibility to entice more attendees.
- The seed library is being revamped and improved. The Friends of Socastee Library purchased plastic containers to hold individual boxes. Although not finished, there are over 1,000 seed packets so far. Many thanks to volunteers for the time committed to this project.

Surfside Library

January

- Surfside Beach Library welcomed new staff member, part-time library assistant Jennifer L. Jennifer has ten years of customer service experience from working in the Tourism/Hospitality industry.
- Youth Services staff hosted several activities during School's Out Day on January 17 with a total of 59 in attendance. New youth services programs included a STEM Robotics Hour and a Baby & Parent Yoga class.
- 60 non-resident cards were issued during the month of January, with an additional 161 resident, reciprocal and juvenile cards for an overall 61% increase of new borrowers from January 2022.
- With the increase in new borrowers, staff also experienced a surge in weekly Device Advice sessions, conducting 27 one-on-one sessions.
- With the beginning of tax season, staff is pleased to report that the application to serve as a participating Tax Form outlet was approved in order to distribute federal forms and instruction booklets. VITA also implemented their first session on January 30.
- With the increase in traffic, staff also experienced an increase in adult program attendance, with consistent turnouts for new activities, such as Coffee and Coloring and the Mystery Book Club, along with increased participation in Trivia, Bingo, NASA Talk, the TAB Book Club and the Mindfulness and Yoga class.

- Youth Services staff planned four different programs for children including a Winter "Penguin Dance" Class, Mixed Media Art class, Read with Penny the Therapy Dog, and a winter themed *Crafternoon*.
- Friends of Surfside Beach Library hosted a Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon on January 25 with 30 people in attendance.

February

- Staff implemented several passive Library Lovers Month and Valentine's Day themed activities, including a performance by the Lowcountry Barbershop Group, Valentine's Day Dinner & Movie, a Tiny Art Show and a Red Hots guessing challenge.
- Staff generated feedback from the public by providing paper hearts that patrons could write what they love about their library as part of Library Lovers Month. Comments included; staff, books, programs, games, the holds shelf and the community puzzle, as well as "Best place ever! Love my library."
- The Branch Librarian and the Youth Services Library Assistant appeared on WPDE's morning show with Amanda Kinseth to promote library services and special collections, featuring a sneak peek of HCML's Tonieboxes for children.
- Youth Services staff hosted several activities during a Mardi Gras School's Out Day on February 21 with a total of 51 in attendance. The day included a dance class, an art class and a read to the dog session.
- Youth Services staff hosted a class field trip and a daycare that participated in a database instruction class and a storytime session.
- Staff utilized the Robotics and Kids' Kitchen programming kits, two book club kits and community helpers and terrific teeth adventure packs for several different storytimes, book clubs and a STEM robotics hour.
- Monthly book sale was held on February 8 and 9 with 168 in attendance.
- The Love & Kindness Book Sale partnered with Backpack Buddies of Horry County to collect non-perishable food items.
- Juvenile discards and donations were used to fill the book bin at Surfside Suds Laundromat.

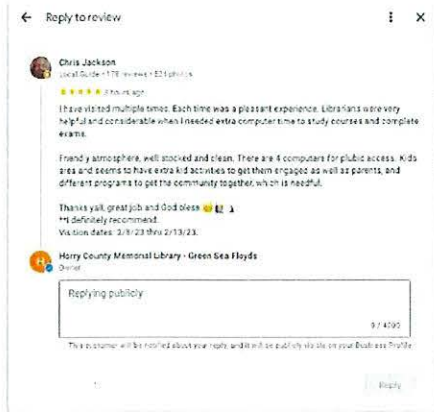
