MOSQUITO SPRAYING SCHEDULE

Horry County will conduct mosquito spraying, weather permitting, in the following areas:

- November 7 – Jordan Road, Hwy 308, Hwy 917 and Calvary Church Road areas.
- November 8 – Maplewild Road, Highway 9 and Fairview Highway area.
- November 8-Gurley Road, Highway 19 and South Highway 701 areas.

Aerial spraying will be conducted in the evenings usually between 7 p.m. and dusk weather permitting.

The chemicals used for mosquito control spraying are approved by the EPA and pose minimal risk to humans or animals. Individuals with asthma or other respiratory illness may wish to stay indoors and close windows and doors during spraying. In addition, homegrown fruits and vegetables should be washed, scrubbed, and/or peeled before eating.

To help keep our honeybee population safe, beekeepers are urged to contact Horry County Stormwater to identify the location of their colonies. In addition, citizens who need to request spraying in their area can contact the Horry County Road & Drainage Hotline at 843-381-8000.

HORRY COUNTY OFFICES TO CLOSE FOR VETERAN'S DAY

Conway, South Carolina – All Horry County offices, other than public safety operations, will be closed on Friday, November 11, 2016, in observance of Veteran's Day. Regular courts may be in operation in the Horry County Government & Justice Center and all jurors, witnesses, etc. will be required to be present.

HORRY COUNTY ANIMAL CARE CENTER TO HOLD VACCINATION CLINIC

Conway, South Carolina – The Horry County Animal Care Center will hold a vaccination clinic, 15 November 2016, from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the animal shelter located at 1923 Industrial Park Road in Conway. The Clinic will offer the following services:

- Distemper/Parvo \$10--must be at least 8-weeks old (*canine*)
- Bordatella \$10--must be at least 8-weeks old (*canine*)
- Rabies \$10--must be at least 4-months old (*canine & feline*)
- Microchip \$15--must be at least 8-weeks old (*canine & feline*)
- Rhinotracheitis/Calici \$10--must be at least 8-weeks old (*feline*)

Dogs and cats are both welcome; dogs must be on a hand-held leash and cats must be in a pet carrier.

The Animal Care Center also holds low cost spay/neuter clinics. These clinics are open to all residents of Horry County for pet dogs and cats. The cost for cats is \$50 (\$20 for residents receiving government assistance) and dogs are just \$80 (\$40 for residents receiving government assistance).

To help homeless animals in Horry County find loving homes, the Animal Care Center will offer discounted adoptions the first Friday and Saturday of each month. Potential adopters are encouraged to visit and spend time with the animal they are interested in. All of the animals are already spayed or neutered and have their shots up to date, however younger animals may need to be returned later to have shots and/or spay/neutering done. The paperwork is easy and only takes a few minutes to fill out. Adoption fees are discounted and typically include spaying/neutering, vaccines, heartworm or leukemia testing, heartworm and flea preventative, intestinal parasite treatment and microchipping. Qualifying new pet parents also get 30-days free pet health insurance and coupons from local pet businesses.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

GLENN'S BAY WIDENING & INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Traffic impacts weather permitting:

Please note: The traffic switch to shift the northbound traffic over to the temporary ramps is scheduled to take place Sunday, November 6, 2016, starting at 6 p.m. and the plan is to have all traffic switched to the new traffic pattern by 6 a.m. the following morning.

- There will be a lane closure on US 17 Bypass from Sutter Drive to St. James Road in the inside northbound lane Sunday, November 6, 2016, between 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. Once one lane of US 17 North traffic is switched to the new ramp the outside northbound lane will be closed for paving and a traffic switch operation.
- There will be a mobile operation on Holmestown Road from US 17 Bypass to Blue Jay Drive for the adjustment of pavement markings at the new signalized intersection Sunday, November 6, 2016, between 6 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- The east and westbound shoulders on Glenn's Bay Road from US 17 Bypass to Ashton Glenn will be closed for utility Relocation work and storm drain installation Friday, November 4, 2016, through Friday, November 11, 2016. Due to the tight right-of-way and the amount of equipment, this shoulder closure will stay in place 24 hours a day. The shoulder closure is staying in place for the safety of the public and no traffic will be inconvenienced, only the shoulder will not be accessible.

HIGHWAY 707 WIDENING PROJECT

Traffic impacts weather permitting:

- There will be intermittent lane closures on Highway 707 between Old Kings Highway and McDowell Shortcut Road South from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, November 6, 2016, through Wednesday, November 9, 2016, for pipeline work.
- There will be intermittent lane closures at the intersection of Highway 707 and Old Kings Highway South from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday, November 7, 2016, through Thursday, November 10, 2016, for pipeline work.
- There will be intermittent lane closures at the intersection of Highway 707 and Holmestown Road from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, November 7, 2016, through Thursday, November 10, 2016 for pipeline and storm drain work.
- There will be intermittent lane closures on Highway 707 between Enterprise Road and Big Block Road from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, November 6, 2016, through Thursday, November 10, 2016, for paving work.
- There will be intermittent lane closures on Highway 707 between McDowell Shortcut Road North and Salem Road from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, November 6, 2016, through Thursday, November 10, 2016, for paving work.
