CITIZEN PARTICIPATION

This significant amendment is being done to the 2008 Annual Plan and includes a citizen participation plan per HUD Guidelines for CDBG-R and CFDA #14.257. The CDBG-R Funds received in late 2008 will be distributed per intergovernmental agreement with The City of Myrtle Beach and The City of Conway as well as Horry County. The City of Myrtle Beach will receive \$117,594.85 in CDBG-R funds per the agreement, City of Conway will receive \$72,148.27 and the remaining \$217,046.87 will be used for projects in Horry County. The Public Hearing Notices and description of fund uses as well as opportunity for citizens input was also displayed on the Horry County website as of April 21, 2009 and in printed form available for Public Review and comment in the CDBG offices, and at the Conway, Loris, Socastee and Myrtle Beach Libraries. Citizen participation was noted. Legal Services of S.C. requested information on applying to Horry County or Grant Subrecipients in order to provide legal services.

Horry County anticipates a joint venture for paving and infrastructure improvement on Pine Island Road within the City of Myrtle Beach and Horry County, for use of some of its funds. Conway CDBG-R funds are proposed to be used for in the new Conway Recreational Complex on Millpond Road, Conway, S.C. Horry County projects will include; repaving of West Cox Ferry Rd. off 544 and safety and playground equipment for County Parks and Recreation, resurfacing & drainage of Pine Island Road and the Recreation Complex, Senior/Community Center on Mill Pond Road in the City of Conway.
