- The Horry County Department of Airports established a DBE Program in accordance with the regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation, 49 CFR Part 26. HCDA has received Federal financial assistance from the DOT and as a condition of receiving this assistance has signed an assurance that it will comply with 49 CFR Part 26.

- We accomplish this by establishing a DBE goal, including the specific DBE requirements in the bid documents and requiring all bidders to meet the requirements prior to being awarded a contract.
