

Rules & Regulations for Vending

Initial

- _____ 1. All tents, canopies, drops & tarpaulins shall be composed of flame-resistant material or shall be treated with a flame retardant to meet the requirements of NFPA 701.
- _____ 2. Portable Fire Extinguishers type (ABC) shall be provided by the vendor.
- _____ 3. Extension cords shall not be frayed, spliced or have missing ground plugs.
- _____ 4. There shall be no missing receptacle covers.
- _____ 5. Right of ways shall be marked.
- _____ 6. Anything w/sleeping quarters shall be required to have an RV permit that is displayed in the entrance door.
(This includes: campers, trailers, rv's, 5th wheels, etc.)
- _____ 7. ALL placards are required to be placed where they are visible by Code Enforcement.
- _____ 8. Any Zoning or Code violations will result in a reduction of the number of vending permits being issued on that TMS # and will extend to the following rallies.
- _____ 9. Vendors setting up without a vending permit from this office could result in the property owner / coordinator being fined a penalty of double the original cost of obtaining a permit or a reduction in number of permits allowed to be pulled.
- _____ 10. All merchandise & tents must be removed no later than the last day of the council approved event or the property owner and/or event coordinator could be fined.
- _____ 11. Two (2) information booths per site will be allowed and determined by site coordinator. No registers or cash boxes will be allowed at these locations.
- _____ 12. NO duplicate permits will be issued. All vendors will purchase a permit and will be displayed for each cash register at that vending site.
(EXAMPLE: 4 Cash registers under 1 tent / 4 Permits under 1 tent)

- _____ 13. All transferred vendors from one overlay to another will be considered a new vendor and will pay all vending fees again.
- _____ 14. If vendor is relocating within the same overlay, they will be charged \$100.00.
- _____ 15. If your placard is lost or misplaced, there will be a \$25 charge for a replacement.
- _____ 16. All temporary signs will be subject to a \$10 fee allowing 1 per location.
- _____ 17. Any violations will result in the event coordinator being fined.
(ie: Sales/Vending without proper placards.)
- _____ 18. Non-Profits not requiring permits shall be: Religious organizations, Fraternal organizations, Government related agencies & Nationally recognized organizations. **(Exempt placards will be of a different color)**
They will be required to provide the county with a copy of their 501C form from the state.
- _____ 19. Tents can be set-up no sooner than the council approved first day of the event.
- _____ 20. There shall be (1) Port-A-John per every (8) vendors set-up.
- _____ 21. Charging for parking is vending and will require a permit.
- _____ 22. Where pedestrians are anticipated to cross highways, appropriate lighting shall be provided. **See attachment for lighting requirements.
- _____ 23. Deadline on obtaining a permit is 48 hrs before beginning date of event.
(Up to 4:30 on Wednesday afternoon.)
Anything issued after that will be charged an additional 50% of permit fee.
- _____ 24. Mobile ATM units are considered to be a vendor and DO REQUIRE A PERMIT. (This will not take away from vending numbers.)
- _____ 25. A minimum of two (2) spaces shall be provided for the parking of county vehicles and will have to be shown on the site plan.
- _____ 26. ALL Adult Entertainment must be screened from the view of public right-of-ways.
