### HORRY COUNTY REGISTRATION & ELECTIONS EXTENDED OFFICE HOURS FOR ABSENTEE VOTING

Conway, South Carolina-The Horry County Registration & Elections Office, located in the Horry County Voters Registration/Election & CDBG Complex, 1515 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Conway will be open Saturday, June 11, 2016, from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m. for absentee voting.

Voters are reminded that June 10, 2016, is the deadline to return absentee by mail applications for the Primary and June 13, 2016, is the deadline to vote absentee in person for the Primary. Voters also should review their registration information to confirm any changes by visiting <http://www.scvotes.org>. The website also has helpful information such as a sample ballot, precinct information and more.

### 2016 PRIMARY ELECTION INFORMATION

- Polls open Tuesday, June 14, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- There are 11 different Republican style ballots and three different Democrat style ballots depending on where you live you in the county.
- 193,043 current active voters in Horry County
- 122 voting precincts in Horry County. 107 of the 122 voting precincts will **NOT** have a Democratic Primary due to no opposition in the party for some of the races. The following precincts **WILL** have a Democratic Primary:
  - *Senate 30* – Aynor, Cool Springs, Galivants Ferry, Methodist/Mill Swamp, and Poplar Hill.
  - *House 57* – Bayboro/Gurley, Hickory Hill, Joyner Swamp, Mt. Olive, Pleasant View, and Taylorsville.
  - *House 103* – Inland, Pawley Swamp, Port Harrelson and Toddville.

- Last day to register to vote in the Primary Election was Saturday, May 14.
- Registered voters will be required to show any one of five forms of identification in order to vote. Voters must show a voter's registration card with a picture, driver's license, a picture ID issued from the Department of Motor Vehicles, any military ID or passport. All forms of identification must be current.
- Monday, June 13, at 5 p.m. is the last day to vote absentee "in-person" at the Horry County Registration & Elections Office, 1515 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Conway.
- Voters are encouraged to review their voter registration information to confirm any changes prior to the upcoming Primary Election by going to [www.scvotes.org](http://www.scvotes.org) under the "Voters" tab on the left. Also, voters unsure of their voting location should contact their county voter registration office at 915-5440 or log onto the State Election Commission website at [www.scvotes.org](http://www.scvotes.org).
- Voters can now go on [www.scvotes.org](http://www.scvotes.org) and pull up their own personal sample ballot.
  - Visit [scvotes.org](http://scvotes.org) and click on "Get My Sample Ballot" on the right side of the page.
  - Enter your county, name, and date of birth to access your voter registration record.
  - Click "View Sample Ballot."
  - Select a party (primaries only), then click the button to download your ballot.
  - Click "OK" to view a .pdf of your ballot.
- Horry County election results can be viewed online at [www.horrycounty.org](http://www.horrycounty.org) after 7 p.m. on June 14. The results will be updated every five minutes. In order to receive the latest information, users will need to hit their "Refresh" or "Reload" button. You will notice that the precinct totals online will be 127....due to these 5 additional categories:
  - Fail Safe – if voters address is different from precinct voter registration list
  - Fail Safe Provisional - registration problems
  - Absentee – voting before hand
  - Provisional – to record a vote when there is some question in regards to a given voter's eligibility
  - Emergency – paper ballot, i.e. machines are down

## **HORRY COUNTY ANIMAL CARE CENTER TO HOLD PET VACCINATION CLINIC**

Conway, South Carolina – The Horry County Animal Care Center will hold a vaccination clinic, 21 June 2016, from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the animal shelter located at 1923 Industrial Park Road in Conway. The Clinic will offer the following services:

- Distemper/Parvo                      \$10--must be at least 8-weeks old (*canine*)
- Bordatella                              \$10--must be at least 8-weeks old (*canine*)
- Rabies                                    \$10--must be at least 4-months old (*canine & feline*)
- Microchip                                \$15--must be at least 8-weeks old (*canine & feline*)
- Rhinotracheitis/Calici                \$10--must be at least 8-weeks old (*feline*)

Dogs and cats are both welcome; dogs must be on a hand-held leash and cats must be in a pet carrier.

The Animal Care Center holds these clinics monthly.

To help homeless animals in Horry County find loving homes, the Animal Care Center will offer discounted adoptions the first Friday and Saturday of each month. Potential adopters are encouraged to visit and spend time with the animal they are interested in. All of the animals are already spayed or neutered and have their shots up to date, however younger animals may need to be returned later to have shots and/or spay/neutering done. The paperwork is easy and only takes a few minutes to fill out. Adoption fees are discounted and typically include spaying/neutering, vaccines, heartworm or leukemia testing, heartworm and flea preventative, intestinal parasite treatment and microchipping. Qualifying new pet parents also get 30-days free pet health insurance and coupons from local pet businesses.

# ROAD CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

## GLENN'S BAY ROAD WIDENING & INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Traffic impacts are as follows:

- The outside eastbound lane of Holmestown Road from Blue Jay Drive to US 17 Bypass will be closed for equipment access Saturday, June 11, 2016, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- The westbound lane will of Glenn's Bay Road from Caropine Drive to Garden Drive will be closed for storm drain installation Sunday, June 12, 2016, between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- The eastbound lane of Glenn's Bay Road from Caropine Drive to US 17 Business will be closed for storm drain installation Monday, June 13, 2016, through Thursday, June 16, 2016, between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- The outside eastbound lane of Holmestown Road from Blue Jay Drive to US 17 Bypass will be closed for equipment access Wednesday, June 15, 2016, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- The westbound lane of Holmestown Road from US 17 Bypass to Blue Jay Drive will be closed for equipment access Monday, June 13, 2016, through Friday, June 17, 2016, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- The east and westbound shoulders Glenn's Bay Road from US 17 Bypass to Ashton Glenn will be closed for utility relocation work and storm drain installation. Due to the tight right-of-way and the amount of equipment, this shoulder closure will need to stay in place 24-hours a day. This will be in place, Friday, June 10, 2016, through Friday, June 17, 2016. The shoulder closure is staying in place for the safety of the public and no traffic will be inconvenienced, only the shoulder will not be accessible.
