GLENN’S BAY WIDENING & INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Traffic impacts weather permitting:

- The outside northbound lane of US 17 Bypass from St. James Road to Sutter Drive will be closed Sunday, July 16, 2017, through Thursday, July 20, 2017, between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. for grading operations.
- There will be a lane closure on Glenn’s Bay Road Sunday, July 16, 2017, through Thursday, July 20, 2017, between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. for paving. The area of closure will be anywhere from US 17 Bypass to US 17 Business and may change each evening.
