PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE WORKSHOP

GLENN'S BAY WIDENING & INTERCHANGE PROJECT

- The eastbound right shoulder of Highway 544 between Pine Hollow Road and the Intracoastal Waterway Bridge will be closed Monday, May 21, 2018, through Friday, May 25, 2018, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for acceleration lane and intersection construction.
