HORRY COUNTY OFFICES TO CLOSE FOR LABOR DAY

HORRY COUNTY LEGACY BUSINESS RECOGNITION

Conway, South Carolina – The Horry County Board of Architectural Review’s Legacy Business Recognition Program will hold a ribbon cutting at the Pine Lakes Country Club August 22, 2018, at 2 p.m.; Horry County Councilman Bill Howard will present the award. The ceremony is free and open to the public.

Founded as the Ocean Forest Golf Club in 1927 and located in the heart of Myrtle Beach, this golf club became known as “The Granddaddy”. It was renamed Pine Lakes International Country Club under the ownership of Fredrick Albert Warner Miles and placed on the National Register of Historic Places November 7, 1996. This golf course has a rich and interesting history. The clubhouse was designed by New York architect, Raymond Hood in the classical revival style and the course itself was designed by architect Robert White who was also the first president of the Professional Golfers’ Association (PGA). In 1954, Pine Lakes became the birthplace of a now world-famous weekly magazine, *Sports Illustrated*. Pine Lakes has recently added the Golf Hall of Fame which honors the men and women who have had significant roles in the Myrtle Beach golf industry. This club is also significant for its association with the growth of Myrtle Beach as a coastal community resort destination.

The Horry County Legacy Business Recognition Program pays tribute to local businesses that have contributed to the economic heritage of Horry County for more than 50-continuous years.

The Pine Lakes Country Club is located at 5603 Granddaddy Drive, in Myrtle Beach.

GLENN’S BAY WIDENING & INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Traffic impacts weather permitting:

- There will be a shoulder closure on Holmestown Road from US 17 Bypass to Blue Jay Drive Monday, August 20, 2018, through Friday, August 24, 2018, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. for sidewalk work.
