MOSQUITO SPRAYING SCHEDULE

For July 14 - July 18, 2010

Horry County will begin mosquito spraying, weather permitting, in the following areas:

- Little River (Due to the weather July 7-July 11, this was rescheduled for this week)

Aerial spraying will be conducted in the evenings usually between 7 p.m. - dusk and ground operations from 7 p.m. - 11 p.m. Monday - Thursday weather permitting.

The chemicals used for mosquito control spraying are approved by the EPA and pose minimal risk to humans or animals. Individuals with asthma or other respiratory illness may wish to stay indoors and close windows and doors during spraying. In addition, homegrown fruits and vegetables should be washed, scrubbed, and/or peeled before eating.

To help keep our honeybee population safe, beekeepers are urged to contact Horry County Mosquito & Spraying to identify the location of their colonies. In addition, citizens with concerns, complaints, or those requesting spraying in their area can also contact Horry County Mosquito & Spraying at 915-5174.

HORRY COUNTY ANIMAL CARE CENTER TO HOLD PET VACCINATION CLINIC

Conway, South Carolina – The Horry County Animal Care Center will hold a vaccination clinic, 24 July 2014, from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the animal shelter located at 1923 Industrial Park Road in Conway. The Clinic will offer the following services:

Distemper/Parvo (canine)	\$10--must be at least 8-weeks old
Bordatella (canine)	\$10--must be at least 8-weeks old
Rabies (canine & feline)	\$10--must be at least 4-months old
Microchip (canine & feline)	\$15--must be at least 8-weeks old
Rhinotracheitis/Calici (feline)	\$10--must be at least 8-weeks old

Dogs and cats are both welcome; dogs must be on a hand-held leash and cats must be in a pet carrier.

The Animal Care Center holds these clinics monthly.

To help homeless animals in Horry County find loving homes, the Animal Care Center will offer discounted adoptions the first Friday and Saturday of each month. Potential adopters are encouraged to visit and spend time with the animal they are interested in. Most of the animals are already spayed or neutered and have their shots up to date, however younger animals may need to be returned later to have shots and/or spay/neutering done. The paperwork is easy and only takes a few minutes to fill out. Adoption fees are discounted and typically include spaying/neutering, vaccines, heartworm or leukemia testing, heartworm and flea preventative, intestinal parasite treatment and micro-chipping. Qualifying new pet parents also get 30-days free pet health insurance and coupons from local pet businesses.

PROPERTY TAX LEGAL RESIDENCE QUALIFICATION PROCEDURES

Conway, South Carolina – The Horry County Assessor's Office would like to remind citizens that a 6% assessment ratio is automatically applied to all property. If the residence will be a primary/legal residence, they may qualify for the lower 4% assessment ratio.

Owners are encouraged to apply for the 4% legal residence assessment ratio by August 1, 2014, to have the lower ratio reflected in their tax bills, which will be mailed in October 2014. The deadline is January 15, 2015.

In order to qualify for the 4% ratio, property owners should download the Horry County Assessor's application located on Horry County Government's website at <http://www.horrycounty.org/portals/0/Docs/assessor/LegalResidence.pdf>. Once the application is filled out, owners will need to provide documentation along with the application. Documentation includes

- South Carolina driver's license or identification cards showing the current address for the owner(s) and spouse
- South Carolina vehicle registration(s) showing the current address for the owner(s) and spouse
- Most recently filed Federal and South Carolina income tax return for the owner(s) and spouse
- South Carolina voter's registration cards for owner(s) and spouse
- If legally separated or divorced, court issued proof of legal separation or divorce
- For members of the United States Military, copies of current orders and military ID
- Other proof may be required as necessary

The application and supporting documents may be brought in person or mailed to the Horry County Assessor's Office, 1301 Second Avenue, Conway, SC 29526. Applications cannot be emailed or faxed.

STATE SENATE DISTRICT 32 SPECIAL ELECTION

Important Dates and Deadlines:

- Noon, Friday, July 4 - Filing Period Opens (County voter registration and elections offices will not be open on July 4. Candidates can begin filing when offices open on Monday morning.)
- Noon, Monday, July 14 - Filing Period Closes.
- August 2 - Voter Registration Deadline for Primary
- September 2 - Primary (if necessary)

- County voter registration and elections offices will not be open on July 4. Candidates can begin filing when offices open on Monday morning.
- Candidates file at the county voter registration and election office in their county of residence.
- The filing fee for this office is \$208. The filing fee is paid by Democratic and Republican party candidates only. Filing fees can be made by check or money order. Filing fee checks should be made out to the appropriate State party.
