ISSUE:

Keep Horry County Beautiful needs to elect Officers for the 2021 calendar year.

CONCLUSION:

Keep Horry County Beautiful should vote among its eligible Board members to serve as Chair and Vice Chair for the 2021 calendar year.

BACKGROUND:

Per the approved bylaws of Keep Horry County Beautiful, the Officers shall be nominated and elected at the end of each calendar year, by a majority vote, if a quorum is present. A discussion can be held to determine interest by Board members to serve as Chair and Vice Chair for the Board. After a nomination is made, nominees must agree to serve. Newly elected officers shall assume office at the first regular meeting of the next calendar year.

The Chairperson shall preside over all meetings and act as official spokesperson for the Committee, event when it is not in session. The Chairperson shall lead the Committee and act as a liaison between the Committee and the Parks and Open Space Board and other County Appointed Committees, as necessary. The Chairperson will serve as an ex-officio member on all subcommittees of Keep Horry County Beautiful. The Vice-Chair shall perform the duties of the Chairperson in his/her absence.

ANALYSIS:

All current KHCB Members are eligible to serve as Chair or Vice-Chair and may be nominated to hold an office for calendar year 2021. April O'Leary has served one term as Chairperson and Jeremy Monday has served one term as Vice Chair.
