2019-2020 ACTION PLAN SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT

January 2, 2020

As a recipient of US Department of Housing grant funding, Horry County is required to notify the public of substantial amendments of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. Myrtle Beach Infrastructure improvements is considered a new project in Year 12 as a part of the amendment. Infrastructure improvements may include, but not be limited to, water and sewer system improvements, stormwater and detention area upgrades, curb and gutter, road paving, sidewalks, and other pedestrian safety measures. Infrastructure improvements will occur in Low to Moderate Income (LMI) neighborhoods within Census Tracts 506 & 507.

A public hearing will be held January 14, 2020 at 3 pm at Myrtle Beach City Hall, 937 Broadway Street, Myrtle Beach, SC 29577 to receive comments on the changes to the Annual Action Plan, as specified below.
